# LEARNING OBJECTIVE

In everyday conversations, especially when talking about life experiences, education, and work, we often need to explain how long an activity has been done and whether it is still continuing up to the present.

For this purpose, the **Present Perfect tense** is used, particularly with the time expressions **since** and **for**.

The Present Perfect tense is a verb tense used to express an activity or situation that:

1. Started in the past, and
2. Still continuing up to the present.

The Present Perfect tense connects the past with the present.

→ She has worked at a travel agency **since** 2016.

→ I have known Timmy **since** we were in high school.

Base Form (V1)	Past Participle (V3)	Example with FOR	Example with SINCE
work	worked	I have worked here <b>for five years.</b>	I have worked here <b>since 2019.</b>
study	studied	I have studied English <b>for three years.</b>	I have studied English <b>since 2021.</b>
live	lived	She has lived in Jakarta <b>for ten years.</b>	She has lived in Jakarta <b>since 2014.</b>
stay	stayed	We have stayed in this city <b>for a long time.</b>	We have stayed here <b>since last year.</b>
learn	learned	I have learned this skill <b>for two years.</b>	I have learned this skill <b>since college.</b>



Time Expression	Function	Example Sentence
Since	Menunjukkan titik awal waktu	I have worked here <b>since 2020</b> .
For	Menunjukkan durasi waktu	I have worked here <b>for four years</b> .
Since + year/date	Waktu spesifik	since 2018, since Monday
For + period	Lama waktu	for two years, for a long time

# Summary

1. The **Present Perfect Tense** is used to describe an action or situation that **started in the past and is still continuing up to the present**.
2. The basic structure of the Present Perfect Tense is **have/has + past participle (V3)**, and it is used in affirmative, negative, and interrogative sentences.
3. The question form "**How long have you...?**" is used to ask about the **duration of an activity** that began in the past and continues now.
4. The time expression **since** is used to indicate a **specific starting point in time**, such as a year, date, or event (since 2016, since high school).
5. The time expression **for** is used to indicate the **length or duration of time** (for five years, for a long time).
6. Present Perfect with **since** and **for** is commonly used in **daily conversations**, especially when talking about **life experience, education, and work experience**.
