



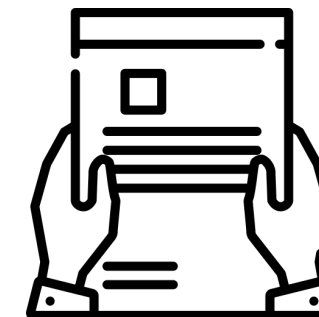
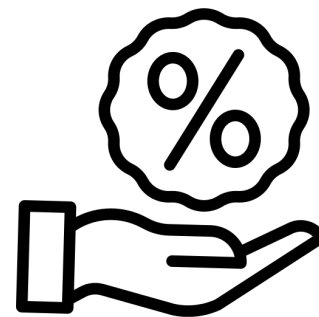

OFFER



An offer is when you *voluntarily* propose to **help** someone, **give** something, or **do** something for others.

Expression:

- Shall I...?
- Would you like...?
- Do you want...?
- How about...?
- Can I...?
- Let me...
- I can... if you like.



OFFER

Structure:

Type	Structure	Example
Making an offer	Shall I + V (base form)?	Shall I help you with your homework?
	Would you like + noun / to + V?	Would you like to sit here?
Accepting	Yes, please. That would be great, thank you. Sure, I'd love some.	
Declining	No, thanks. I'm okay, but thank you. That's kind, but maybe later.	



OFFER: modal

Some of the offer sentences use **modal verbs**

Modal Verbs:

CAN	Ability	She <i>can</i> swim.
COULD	Possibility	It <i>could</i> rain tomorrow.
MAY	Permission	May I use your phone?
MIGHT	Possibility	He <i>might</i> be at home.
MUST	Necessity	You <i>must</i> wear a suit.
SHOULD	Advice	You <i>should</i> call her.
WILL	Future	I <i>will</i> be there.

Modal Verb	Level of Politeness
Would	Very Polite
Shall	Polite (British)
May	Formal Politeness
Can	Neutral / casual
Could	More Polite than <i>Can</i>

“Should” is not for offering;
use “Shall” instead
