


WHY LEARN GREETING?



	Good morning	Good morning, Mr. Smith.
	Good afternoon	Good afternoon, everyone.
	Good evening	Good evening, ladies and gentlemen.
Formal	How do you do?	How do you do, Professor Clark?
	It's a pleasure to meet you	It's a pleasure to meet you, Mrs. Johnson.
	Nice to meet you	Nice to meet you, Sir.
	Greetings	Greetings, everyone.
	Hi / Hello	Hi, John! / Hello, everyone!
	Hey	Hey, Mike!
	What's up?	What's up, Alex?
Informal	How's it going?	How's it going, Sarah?
	How are you?	Hey, Tom! How are you?
	Yo (slang)	Yo, man! Long time no see!
	Hiya (British informal)	Hiya, mate!

Starting a conversation	Good morning / May I have your attention, please?	Hey guys / Yo everyone / Listen up!
Introducing someone else	I would like to introduce my colleague, Mr. John Smith.	This is my buddy John / Meet my friend John
Introducing two people	Let me introduce you to Mr. Anderson. Mr. Anderson, this is Ms. Brown.	John, this is Sarah / Sarah, meet John
Describing the person	He is our new manager from the marketing department.	He's the new guy in marketing / She's my bestie
Asking if they know each other	Have you two met before?	You guys know each other, right?
Closing the introduction	It's a pleasure to have you here / I hope you two get along well.	Alright, catch up later / Cool, see you around
